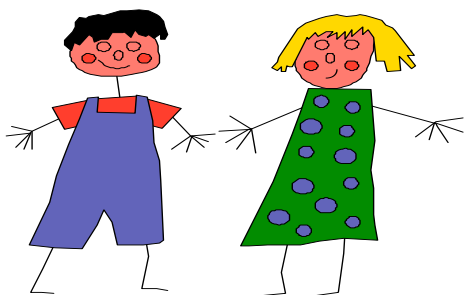

NON-UNIFORM DAY

11 November 2011



We will be having a non-uniform day on Friday 11 November.

It is not compulsory that children take part in this event but if your child/children would like to attend school in non-uniform, would you please donate bottles for the School Fair. (all alcoholic drinks should be brought in by an adult and obviously no hazardous materials such as bleach etc. should be sent to school).

LUNCHTIME ARRANGEMENTS

Just to remind everyone regarding lunchtime arrangements:-

Dinner money must be brought to school on Monday morning each week, in a named sealed envelope, clearly marked with your child's name, class and the amount enclosed. Despite reminders we still have a few families who do not do this. Many thanks to those parents who always pay on time.

Packed lunches may be consumed on the premises at lunchtime. All food brought from home must be packed appropriately and labelled with your child's name. No hot fluids or glass bottles are allowed in school. If you can possibly avoid fizzy drinks particularly in cans, that would also be much appreciated. Sweets and chewing gum, not allowed in school, should not form part of a packed lunch. Healthy food is the order of the day.

If you wish to alter arrangements for lunchtimes e.g. change to or from school meals, then please allow a week's notice to the change.

MEDICINES IN SCHOOL

Although we are reluctant to administer medicines in school, there may be circumstances that require individuals to take medication during the school day. If this is the case it should be brought to the Head Teacher's office, together with written instructions regarding the administration, dosage, timing and reason for the treatment. Parents will be asked to sign a consent form – available from the office. Failure to do so will result in the medicine NOT being administered. No medicine of any description should be sent into school without the Head Teacher being notified.
